## REPORT OF THE BOARD

Stichting TB Europe Coalition (hereinafter – TBEC or the Foundation) is registered at the Dutch Chamber of Commerce in Amsterdam with registration number 858222565.

The members of the TBEC Board are pleased to present the Foundation’s 2023 financial statement.

### *Vision, Mission and Core Values*

TBEC **vision**: a world free of TB.

TBEC **mission**: civil society driving the TB response.

TBEC maintains a commitment to the following **core values**:

- Empowerment: TBEC believes that people’s needs should be at the centre of any TB decision-making. As such TBEC seeks to empower civil society and TB affected communities to actively participate in the TB response.
- Human rights-based approach to TB: A human rights-based approach to TB prioritises the dignity and autonomy of all people with TB. TBEC is committed to promoting and defending the rights of TB affected people.
- Equality & Social Justice: TBEC holds to the principles of promoting and defending health equality, with special focus given to engaging and empowering vulnerable and marginalised groups in TB affected communities.
- Independence, Transparency and Accountability: TBEC only accepts funding from donors whose objectives are in line with its vision and core value. Furthermore, TBEC maintains a policy of transparency and disclosure for its beneficiaries, donors, and partners.

### *Objectives*

The objective of the Foundation is

- to further the achievement of a world free of tuberculosis and support community, humanitarian, social, health promotion, medical and scientific activities throughout the world and especially within Europe and Central Asia (the European Region of the World Health Organisation) for the care , relief , and rehabilitation of persons affected by tuberculosis and related medical and social conditions , and for the prevention and management of that disease;
- to support general community, humanitarian, social, health promotion, medical and scientific activities throughout the world and especially within Europe and Central Asia (the European Region of the World Health Organisation);
- as also to accept bequests with the benefit of inventory; and to perform all such further acts and activities as are in the widest sense connected therewith, incidental thereto and / or which may be conducive thereto.

The Foundation makes every effort inter alia to attain and accomplish its objective by:

- being a regional civil society network bringing together both individuals and organisations from across the region in order to strengthen the role of civil society within the regional response to tuberculosis, health and well - being, and to increase the political and financial commitment required to effectively manage both the tuberculosis epidemic, and increase the health and well-being of all persons; and
- collaborating with medical, governmental, private, and civil society bodies of all types.

The Foundation does not have the objective to make profits.

## ***Projects***

In 2023, TBEC have 5 big projects and 4 small ones:

- 4) Operational EU-funded Project “Enhancing the capacity and capability of European civil society to drive a person-centred TB response in Europe 2.0”
- 5) as a service provider for the UNICEF – “Support community-based health care services for children and mothers at SPILNO Children Points and Centers for Internally displaced people”
- 6) as a service-provider for GF TA Project “CCM Evolution Engagement Communities Election Process – Kazakhstan”;
- 7) as a service-provider for GF TA Project “TBEC CCM Evolution Engagement Election Process Support in Tajikistan and Uzbekistan”;
- 8) as a service-provider for GF TA Project “To support meaningful engagement of communities in NFM4 processes in Ukraine”

## **Generally accepted accounting principles for valuation and determination of results**

### ***Accounting policies***

The financial statements have been prepared in conformity with generally accepted accounting principles in the Netherlands. The statements are based on a reporting period of one year. The fiscal year coincides with the calendar year. The financial statements are presented in Euros, rounded to the nearest Euro. Transactions denoted in foreign currencies are converted using the Central European Bank's exchange rate on the date of transaction. Monetary assets and liabilities denoted in foreign currencies are translated using the Central European Bank's exchange rate on the balance sheet date. All assets and liabilities are recorded at nominal value.
